Notes from the new Neighborhood Vitality Group on September 30, 2023

The second Iron Horse Village Neighborhood Vitality Group (NVG) Committee Meeting took place on September 30,2023 and was live stream on the IHV Facebook Page. Notes from the meeting were posted on the Facebook page on October 1, 2023. Topics

- Neighborhood Crime Prevention Specialist (CPS): IHV is under the jurisdiction
 of Officer A. Paredes who tracks any topics labeled crime in our area. Officer
 Parades provided a <u>LINK</u> to the crime statistics for our neighborhood which can
 also be found on our Facebook Page. If you would like the crime statistics you can
 sign up via this <u>LINK</u>.
- Neighborhood Vitality Group (NVG): The Homeowner representatives of the Neighborhood Vitality Group that will work with the City of Mesquite are as follows: Dahmahlee, Meris and Martina. They will work with Estefania Sosa from the City of Mesquite on the open items
- Lighting our Streets: The NVG is coordinating with the City of Mesquite to obtain product information for solar street lights for IHV. In addition to product information, the NVG is also seeking a proposed location plan indicating where the streetlights could go. All information will be shared with the HOA and Homeowners.
- Lighting our Home: During the NVG meeting that took place on 09.30.2023, Officer
 Paredes noted that until the street light situation is resolved, Homeowners should
 turn on their porch and house number signs to help light the street overnight. If a
 Homeowner has an alarm system, the entry porch light and house number lights
 are both programmable your alarm service provider can walk you through the set
 up.
- Flock Cameras: The City of Mesquite will coordinate this effort between the HOA
 and the City of Mesquite to determine funding requirements and procure bids.
- Neighborhood Cameras: The HOA Board to determine next steps and inform Homeowners.
- Doorbell Alarm Camera Registration with MPD: You can register your home alarm cameras with the City of Mesquite Police Depart HERE
- Crime Watch posted signage: NVG City of Mesquite representative is coordinating
 with Essex Management for the procurement and installation of the signage. The
 cost to the HOA is \$75 for a minimum of 25 signs (inclusive of posts and installation).

AMENITIES
